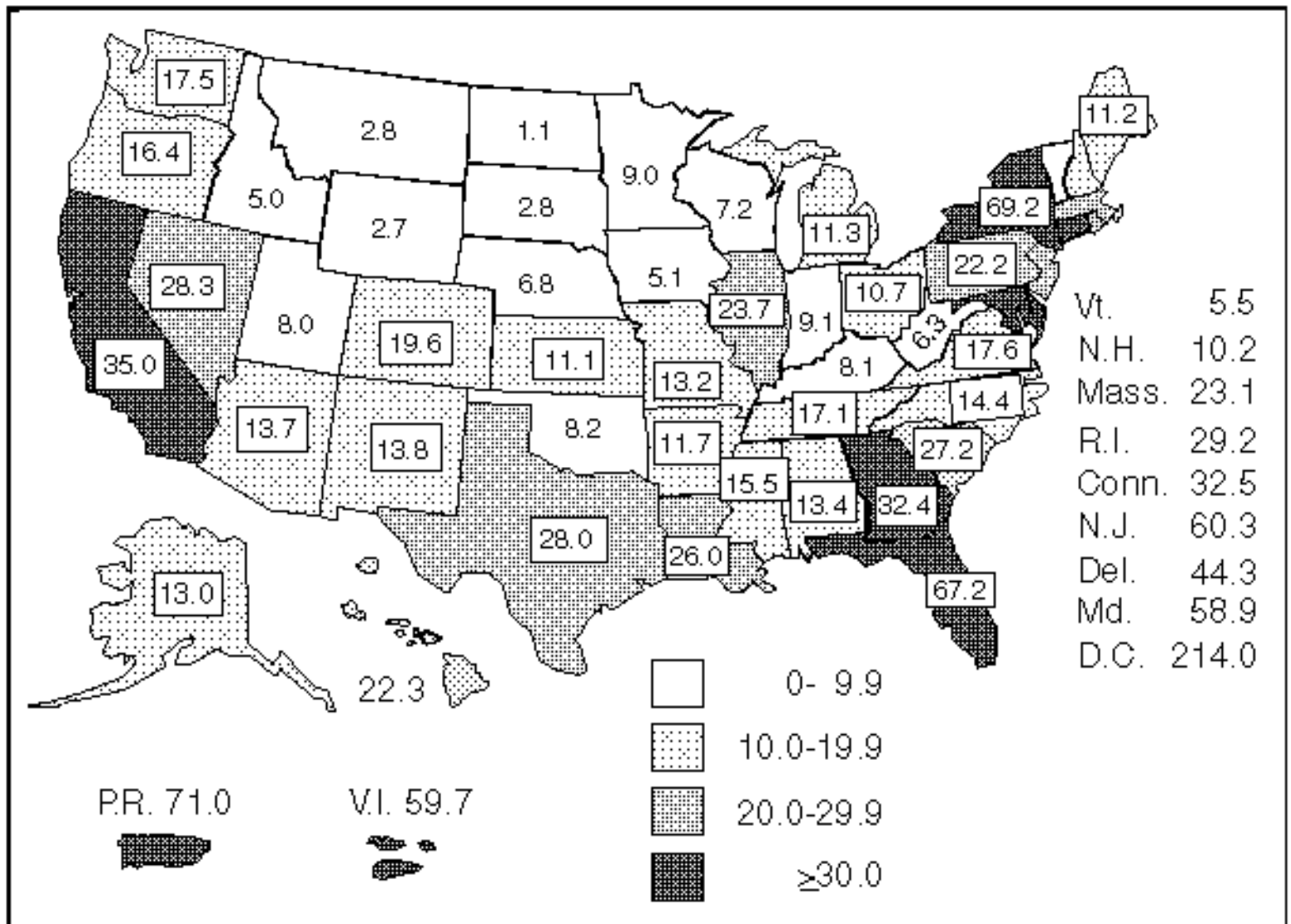


AIDS Map
