

Physics 106 - How Things Work II - Spring 2007

Tips for Submitting Homework via E-Class

1. You must be registered for Physics 106 to enter the E-Class Site.
2. If you have recently “added-in”, it may take a day or so for us to add you to the E-class system as a user.
3. Your User ID is your UVA Mail Handle, typically 5 characters like “zag3d”. Initially, your password is also your UVA Mail Handle. **CHANGE YOUR PASSWORD THE FIRST TIME YOU LOG IN.** Otherwise, everyone who wants to can access your E-class account.
4. Because the connection to the E-Class Site involves a secure protocol, you must agree to proceed when asked to accept the sites security certificate.
5. Once in E-Class, scroll down to How Things Work II Spring 2007 and click. Note there will be E-Class links to How Things Work II from previous years. You must choose the Spring 2007 semester link with my name (Gordon Cates) as Instructor.
6. Once in How Things Work II, you should be able to view, work on, and submit available assignments and solutions.
7. Note that you can “save” your homework without submitting it. While this is a useful feature of the system, keep in mind that you must both “save” and “submit” for us to receive your homework.
8. Once you submit your homework, you will receive a “receipt” via email. Make certain that you save this receipt. You may need it if there are any difficulties later.
