

## Physics 106 - How Things Work II - Spring 2008

### Tips for Submitting Homework via E-Class

---

1. You must be registered for Physics 106 to enter the E-Class Site.
2. If you have recently “added-in”, it may take a day or so for us to add you to the E-class system as a user. Still, let me know right away if you are unable to log in using the instructions below.
3. Follow the link to eclass from the course web page, the email you received, or use the url: <http://eclass2.phys.virginia.edu/>
4. Because the connection to the E-Class Site involves a secure protocol, you must agree to proceed if or when you are asked to accept the site’s security certificate.
5. Once in E-Class, you will either be viewing a login page, or you will have the choice to choose from more than one course. If necessary, click on How Things Work II Spring 2008 with Gordon Cates as the instructor.
6. Your User ID is your UVA Mail Handle, typically 5 characters like “zag3d”. Initially, your password is also your UVA Mail Handle. Your password is NOT whatever password you are currently using for mail or other CIT accounts. **CHANGE YOUR PASSWORD THE FIRST TIME YOU LOG IN.** Otherwise, everyone who wants to can access your E-class account.
7. Once in How Things Work II, you should be able to view, work on, and submit available assignments and solutions.
8. Note that you can “save” your homework without submitting it. While this is a useful feature of the system, keep in mind that you must both “save” and “submit” for us to receive your homework.
9. Once you submit your homework, you will receive a “receipt” via email. Make certain that you save this receipt. You may need it if there are any difficulties later.
