

JAMES HARRIGAN

Biographical Summary

James Harrigan is a Professor in the Economics Department at the University of Virginia. During the 2018-2019 academic year, he will be a Visiting Professor at the Paris School of Economics. He conducts research on economic inequality, international trade, and economic geography.

Mr. Harrigan joined the University of Virginia in 2008. Before that, he was an economist at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York for twelve years. He has also taught at Sciences Po in Paris, Columbia University and the University of Pittsburgh, and is a Research Associate at the National Bureau of Economic Research in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Mr. Harrigan has published many articles in leading scholarly journals, and is a former Co-Editor of *The Journal of International Economics*.

Mr. Harrigan earned a Ph.D. in economics from the University of California at Los Angeles. He lives in Charlottesville, Virginia with his wife and two children.
